- A Managing Breeder Agreement **MUST BE SUBMITTED BY EACH INDIVIDUAL/ENTITY** in the partnership listed as Breeder of Record.
- The forms must be signed, dated, have a public notary stamp, and be on file with the MHBA before any bonus/award checks are sent to the designated Managing Breeder.
- The designated Managing Breeder will be responsible for dispersing any bonuses/awards earned by the partnership listed on this form.
